

RESOLUTION 2018-15

A Resolution of the Four Corner County Water and Sewer to allow Irrigation Wells for Residential Lots 1 Acres or Larger.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Four Corners County Water and Sewer District ("District") is a county water and sewer district duly established in 2003;

WHEREAS, the District currently allows irrigation wells to be used for commercial lots of two acres or larger; and

WHEREAS, the District has received requests for allowing irrigation wells on residential lots of one (1) acre or larger as well as less than one acre; has considered the information regarding the number of lots, the sizes of residential lots within the District; the costs of wells; the volume reduction of using treated water for irrigation; and the impacts to the environmental as well as the financial impacts to the District. Additionally, if the homeowner wishes to have an irrigation well they will need to go through the DNRC exempt well permit process.

NOW THEREFORE, based upon the information considered and public comment, if any, the Four Corners County Water and Sewer District resolves to allow residential lots of one acre or larger to obtain permission from the District and drill wells for irrigation uses only. The District shall impose the same construction and implementation requirements on residential irrigation wells as is imposed on commercial irrigation wells to ensure cross-contamination does not occur. This policy is effective immediately upon passage.
